AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to interest to be recovered upon a sum awarded in certain circumstances

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 5001 of the civil practice law and rules is amended to read as follows:

- 3 (a) Actions in which recoverable. Interest shall be recovered upon a 4 sum awarded because of a breach of performance of a contract, or because 5 of an act or omission depriving or otherwise interfering with title to, 6 or possession or enjoyment of, property, or for personal injury, except that in an action of an equitable nature, interest and the rate and date 6 from which it shall be computed shall be in the court's discretion.
  - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
