AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to defining a day student for employment purposes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 511 of the labor law, as amended 2 by chapter 1091 of the laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

- 9. Day student. The term "employment" does not include service <u>solely</u> performed during [all or any part of the school year or] regular vacation periods [as a part time worker of] by any person actually in regular attendance [during the day time] as a student in an elementary or secondary school.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
