AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to costs associated with the establishment of New York state veterans' cemeteries

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraphs (b) and (g) of subdivision 2 of section 365 of the executive law, paragraph (b) as added by section 5 of part W of chapter 57 of the laws of 2013, the opening paragraph of paragraph (b) and paragraph (q) as amended by section 11 of part AA of chapter 56 of the laws of 2019, are amended to read as follows:

(b) [Prior to the commencement of the investigation and study pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subdivision, the director of the division of veterans' services, the director of the division of the budget, the] The director of the department of state's division of cemeteries, and the office of the state comptroller must certify to the governor, the tempo-11 rary president of the senate, the speaker of the assembly, the chair of 12 the senate finance committee and the chair of the assembly ways and 13 means committee that [the veterans remembrance and cemetery maintenance 14 and operation fund, created pursuant to section ninety seven mmmm of the 15 state finance law, contains at the commencement of the application 16 process pursuant to paragraph (e) of this subdivision there are moneys sufficient, adjusted to reflect projected future inflation, to fund the 18 <u>non-reimbursable costs related to future</u> operation[7] <u>and</u> maintenance [and the provision of perpetual care] of a state veterans' cemetery for a period of not less than $[\frac{\text{fifteen}}{\text{ten}}]$ $\underline{\text{ten}}$ years, provided that such amount 20 shall not include [any amount that shall be reimbursed or contributed to 22 the cometery from the government of the United States or] any amount 23 that would be recoverable by the cemetery pursuant to a charge of fee 24 for the provision of a grave site for a non-veteran spouse or family 25 member; provided further that such moneys may include the veterans 26 remembrance and cemetery maintenance and operation fund created pursuant 27 to section ninety-seven-mmmm of the state finance law. director of the division of the budget, the director of the department of state's division of cemeteries, and the office of the state comptroller shall consider, but are not limited to, the following factors:

- (i) physical attributes of the veterans cemetery, including size, location, and terrain;
 - (ii) [management and operation, including] staffing costs, cost of equipment and equipment maintenance, and security costs;
- (iii) relevant state and federal requirements and specifications for interment and perpetual care;
- (iv) estimates provided by the United States department of veterans 10 11 affairs;
 - (v) any other non-reimbursable fiscal cost, charge or assessment that would be incurred by the cemetery.
 - (g) Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize the division of veterans' services to [commence an investigation and study pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subdivision, issuing a request for proposals pursuant to paragraph (c) of this subdivision, selecting a site for the first New York state veterans' cometery pursuant to paragraph (d) of this subdivision, or submitting | submit any application for funding from the government of the United States in accordance with the grant requirements specified in section 2408 of title 38 of the United States code, part 30 of title 38 of the code of federal regulations, and other relevant federal statutes or regulations, for the purpose of seekfunds to support the construction, establishment, expansion, improvement, support, operation, or maintenance [and the provision of perpetual care of New York state's [first] veterans' cemetery pursuant to paragraph (e) of this subdivision until the [funds in the veterans remembrance and demetery maintenance and operation fund have been derti**fied**] completion of the certification pursuant to paragraph (b) of this subdivision.
- 31 § 2. Section 353 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 32 subdivision 25 to read as follows:
- 25. To make widely available to the public via, among other things, 34 publication on the division's website and free mobile application pursuant to subdivision fourteen-a of this section, information regarding the 36 veterans remembrance and cemetery maintenance and operation fund established pursuant to section ninety-seven-mmmm of the state finance law.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
