AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to providing a one hundred dollar per day credit to customers of electric and gas corporations for power outages of twenty-four hours or more

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 73 to read as follows:

§ 73. Power outage credit. Every electric corporation and gas corpotation in this state shall provide its customers with a credit to such
customers' accounts at any time a customer is without power for a period
of time in excess of twenty-four hours. Such credit shall be in the
mount of one hundred dollars for each twenty-four hour period that a
customer is without power and shall only be credited to the account of
each customer of such corporation who has been without power for such
period of time. Credit to a customer's account made pursuant to this
section shall be used to pay charges against such account assessed by
the electric corporation or gas corporation and such customer shall not
be required to pay on such account until such credit has been completely
exhausted.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
