AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating the animal control officer in the town of Sand Lake as a peace officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new subdivision 60 to read as follows:
- 60. The animal control officer of the town of Sand Lake, Rensselaer county, who at the discretion of the town board of the town of Sand Lake may be designated as a constable for the purpose of enforcing article twenty-six of the agriculture and markets law, and for the purpose of issuing appearance tickets permitted under article seven of such law; provided, however, that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to authorize such officer to carry, possess, repair or dispose of a firearm unless the appropriate license therefor has been issued pursuant to section 400.00 of the penal law.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
