AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation enacting the "Make Voting Easy Act" to require that the board of elections designate at least one early voting polling place for every full increment of twenty-five thousand registered voters in each county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "Make Voting Easy Act".

- § 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 8-600 of the election law, as added by chapter 6 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The board of elections shall designate polling places for early voting, which may include the offices of the board of elections, for 8 persons to vote early pursuant to this title. There shall be so designated at least one early voting polling place for every full increment of [fifty] twenty-five thousand registered voters in each county; 11 provided, [however, the number of early voting polling places in a county ty shall not be required to be greater than seven, and a county with 13 fewer than [fifty] twenty-five thousand voters shall have at least one early voting polling place.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to any 16 general, primary, run-off primary, or special election held thereafter.
