AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to permitting the Binghamton city school district to establish an insurance reserve fund

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 6-n of the general municipal law, as separately amended by chapters 318, 321, 325, 342, 2 499, 509, 510 and 551 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:

3 (a) The governing board of any municipal corporation may establish a 4 reserve fund to be known as the insurance reserve fund. Upon the 5 creation of the fund, the municipality may make expenditures from the 6 fund for any loss, claim, action or judgment for which the municipal 7 corporation is authorized or required to purchase or maintain insurance, 8 except those kinds of risks for which insurance is authorized pursuant 9 to paragraph one, two, three, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, 10 twenty-two or twenty-three of subsection (a) of section one thousand one 11 hundred thirteen of the insurance law, or for payments in lieu of 12 contributions under article eighteen of the labor law; provided however, 13 that no municipality shall make an expenditure from such fund for any 14 loss, claim, action or judgment for which the municipal corporation has 15 established a reserve fund under any other provision of law; provided, 16 further that the Scarsdale union free school district, the Mamaroneck 17 union free school district, the Minisink Valley central school district, 18 the Vernon Verona Sherrill central school district, [and] the Ithaca 19 city school district [and], the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda union free 20 school district, [and] the Bedford central school district [and], the 21 Grand Island central school district [and], the Tonawanda city school 22 district [and], the enlarged city school district of Middletown [and], 23 the Frontier central school district, and the Binghamton city school 24 district may establish insurance reserve funds in compliance with this 25 section and article seventy-four of the education law and such school 26 districts may make expenditures in compliance with this section and 27 28
