- AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to permitting unemployment benefits in the case of voluntary separation from employment during the COVID-19 emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 593 of the labor law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

1-a. Voluntary separation during the COVID-19 declared emergency. A 3 4 claimant shall not be disqualified from receiving benefits for voluntary 5 separation from employment during the period of declared emergency under 6 Executive Order 202, where such claimant; (a) is sixty-five years of age 7 or older; (b) has an underlying health condition that puts such employee especially at-risk for severe illness from COVID-19, including, but not 8 9 limited to chronic pulmonary, lung, liver or kidney disease; or (c) such 10 claimant lives with a family member who is sixty-five years of age or 11 older or who has an underlying condition that puts them at-risk for 12 severe illness due to COVID-19 and such employment would result in 13 potential exposure to COVID-19. 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
