AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to a centralized database for participation in response to a declared state emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 719 to 2 read as follows:

§ 719. Centralized database for participation in emergency response.

Within six months of the effective date of this section, the division shall create and maintain a centralized database of companies and organizations that can be part of the state's emergency response system to provide goods and services during a period of emergency or disaster declared by the governor. The division shall conduct outreach efforts to develop the database that shall function as a clearinghouse to identify businesses and organizations that are able to produce and provide critical products and services which are needed during a period of emergency or disaster. The division shall communicate with businesses to facilitate needed production and procurement of and shall coordinate distribution of needed products and services.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
