AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to requiring
that all police officers involved in the execution of a search warrant
wear body cameras

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 690.50 of the criminal procedure law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3 3-a. A search warrant shall not be executed without the execution of
4 such warrant being recorded by a functioning and unobstructed body
5 camera or other functioning and unobstructed video recording device.
6 Each police officer involved in the execution of a search warrant must
7 wear a functioning and unobstructed body camera that shall be active
8 prior to and throughout the execution of the search and during any
9 related action following the execution of the search warrant, including,
10 but not limited to the securing of persons or evidence.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
12 have become a law.
