AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the manufacturing of portable electronic devices

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new article 40 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 40

PORTABLE ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- § 900. Manufacturing requirements. 1. For the purposes of this
 section, "portable electronic device" shall mean any hand-held mobile
 telephone, as defined by subdivision one of section twelve hundred twenty-five-c of the vehicle and traffic law, personal digital assistant
 (PDA), or handheld device with mobile data access.
- 2. On and after January first, two thousand twenty-two, no manufacturer shall provide for sale in this state any portable electronic device not equipped with an ATSC 3.0 chip.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
