AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to authorizing home confinement for certain prisoners during a declared state of emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The correction law is amended by adding a new section 607 2 to read as follows:
- § 607. Home confinement authority. 1. For purposes of this section,

 "covered emergency period" shall mean the period beginning on the date

 on which a state disaster emergency has been declared by the governor

 pursuant to article two-B of the executive law and ending on the date

 that is thirty days after the date on which such state disaster emergency has been lifted.
- 2. During a covered emergency period, if the commissioner shall determine that emergency conditions will materially affect the functioning of
 the department, the commissioner shall have the authority to place any
 prisoner in home confinement for a period of time that the commissioner
 deems appropriate.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
