AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to requiring certain records which are the subject of a discussion conducted at an open meeting be made available to the public at least twenty-four hours prior thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (e) of section 103 of the public officers law, as added by chapter 603 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

4 (e) Agency records available to the public pursuant to article six of 5 this chapter, as well as any proposed resolution, law, rule, regulation, policy or any amendment thereto, that is scheduled to be the subject of б 7 discussion by a public body during an open meeting shall be made avail-8 able, upon request therefor, to the extent practicable as determined by 9 the agency or the department, at least twenty-four hours prior to [or 10 at] the meeting during which the records will be discussed. Copies of 11 such records may be made available for a reasonable fee, determined in 12 the same manner as provided therefor in article six of this chapter. If the agency in which a public body functions maintains a regularly and 13 14 routinely updated website and utilizes a high speed internet connection, 15 such records shall be posted on the website to the extent practicable as 16 determined by the agency or the department, at least twenty-four hours 17 prior to the meeting. An agency may, but shall not be required to, 18 expend additional moneys to implement the provisions of this subdivi-19 sion.

20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
