AN ACT in relation to granting on-premise alcohol retailers an extension  
of one year to renew their expired liquor license without any late  
fees during the COVID-19 state disaster emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
- 2 if an on-premise alcohol retailer has experienced a renewal date for
- 3 their New York state liquor license between the date a state disaster
- 4 emergency was declared by the governor pursuant to executive order 202
- 5 and December 31, 2020, such retailer shall receive an extension of one
- 6 year from the time such liquor license has expired to renew such
- 7 license, and no late fees shall be charged for such extension.
- 8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
