AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to prohibiting rent minimums in mortgages

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 2 283 to read as follows:

§ 283. Rent minimums prohibited. No mortgagor on a loan secured primarily by an interest in real property shall be charged a fee, forced to default, or otherwise penalized by the mortgagee because the mortgagor did not set a high enough rent on all or part of such real property. All terms of a mortgage which would cause a mortgagor to be penalized for not setting a high enough rent shall be void and unenforceable as against public policy.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all 11 mortgages regardless of when issued, renewed, modified, altered or 12 amended.
