AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to mandatory counseling for minor victims of a sex offense and the parent or guardian of such victims

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 625 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

2-a. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of this article, and without regard to the financial difficulty of the claimant, a victim of a sex offense, as such sex offense is defined in article one hundred thirty of the penal law, and the parent or guardian of such victim if such victim is a minor, shall obtain counseling from a psychiatrist or licensed psychologist prior to filing a claim for receipt of an award pursuant to this article. A letter issued from such victim's treating psychiatrist or licensed psychologist shall be filed along with such victim's claim.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
