AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to duties of providers of service to people with developmental disabilities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 16.13 of the mental hygiene law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision (e) to read as follows:

3 (e) Posting a visible notice in a common area. Programs licensed,
4 certified, operated, or authorized by the office shall post signs
5 informing individuals to call 911 in the event of an emergency. Such
6 signs shall be posted and visible in common areas, be not less than
7 eight and one-half inches by eleven inches and shall read: "In case of
8 an emergency, dial 911".

9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after
10 it shall have become a law.
