AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to health care
proxy information on driver's licenses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 504 of the vehicle and traffic law, as separately amended by chapters 568 and 639 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

2 (a) Every license or renewal thereof shall contain a distinguishing
3 mark and adequate space upon which an anatomical gift, pursuant to
4 section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law, by the licensee shall be recorded and shall contain such other information and shall
5 be issued in such form as the commissioner shall determine; provided,
6 however, every license or renewal thereof issued to a person under the
7 age of twenty-one years shall have prominently imprinted upon it the
8 statement "UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE" in notably distinctive print or
9 format; provided further, however, every license or renewal thereof
10 issued to a person making an anatomical gift shall have prominently
11 printed upon the front of such license or renewal thereof the statement
12 "ORGAN DONOR" in notably distinctive print or format; and provided
13 further that every license shall have imprinted on the back, "If you
14 have completed a health care proxy form, you may list your health care
15 agent here:" followed by space for the health care agent's name and
16 contact information. The commissioner shall not require fees for the
17 issuance of such licenses or renewals thereof to persons under twenty-
18 one years of age or to persons making an anatomical gift which are
19 different from the fees required for the issuance of licenses or
20 renewals thereof to persons twenty-one years of age or over or to
21 persons not making an anatomical gift.

22 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
23 it shall have become a law.
