AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to reporting a nonemergency incident to an organization having the function of dealing with emergencies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.49 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 240.49 Reporting a nonemergency incident.
- A person is guilty of reporting a nonemergency incident when, knowing
- 5 the information reported, conveyed or circulated to be a nonemergency
- 6 situation, he or she initiates or circulates a report or warning to an
- 7 official or quasi-official agency or organization having the function of
- 8 dealing with emergencies involving danger to life or property of an
- 9 <u>alleged occurrence or impending occurrence of a nonemergency situation</u>
- 10 <u>in which it is unlikely that a threat to public safety will result.</u>
- 11 Reporting a nonemergency incident is a class B misdemeanor.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
