AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to reporting a nonemergency incident to an organization having the function of dealing with emergencies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.49 to read as follows: <u>\$ 240.49 Reporting a nonemergency incident.</u> <u>A person is guilty of reporting a nonemergency incident when, knowing</u> <u>the information reported, conveyed or circulated to be a nonemergency</u> <u>situation, he or she initiates or circulates a report or warning to an</u> <u>official or quasi-official agency or organization having the function of</u> <u>dealing with emergencies involving danger to life or property of an</u> <u>alleged occurrence or impending occurrence of a nonemergency situation</u> <u>in which it is unlikely that a threat to public safety will result.</u>

11 <u>Reporting a nonemergency incident is a class B misdemeanor.</u>

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
