AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to the prohibition of the use of passenger trains without conductors in certain circumstances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1277-b to read as follows:
- 3 § 1277-b. Use of passenger trains without conductors prohibited in 4 certain circumstances. Any passenger train operating without the use of 5 a conductor is prohibited from passing under any body of water.
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 7 have become a law.
