AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to creating the career and practical education pathway to a high school diploma

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 817 to 2 read as follows:
- § 817. Career and practical education pathway to a high school diploma. 1. a. A career and practical education (CPE) pathway to a high school diploma is hereby established. A CPE pathway to a diploma, made available by a school district shall:
 - (i) result in a general diploma;

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- 8 <u>(ii) differ from the traditional requirements to a general diploma</u>
 9 <u>with respect to required assessments, except as otherwise required by</u>
 10 <u>federal law; and</u>
- 11 (iii) be made available to all students, including students with disa-12 bilities and English language learners.
- b. A CPE pathway to a diploma shall be based on a course of study
 designed to provide students with practical knowledge and skills and
 shall demonstrate that the student is ready for a career as determined
 by regulations of the board of regents. A CPE pathway to a diploma shall
- 17 <u>include</u>, but not be limited to:
- (i) completion of a CPE course of study;
- 19 (ii) completion of school given final exams;
- 20 <u>(iii) completion of work-based learning experiences as provided by the</u> 21 state approved program; and
- 22 (iv) completion of a work-skills employability profile.
- 23 c. For purposes of this section, a career and practical education
- 24 shall include, but not be limited to, a course of study in the following
- 25 career fields: agriculture education, business and marketing education,

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- 1 <u>family and consumer sciences education, health occupations education,</u>
 2 <u>technical education, technology education, practical arts education and</u>
 3 <u>trade and industrial education.</u>
- 2. The board of regents shall promulgate such regulations to the commissioner as may be necessary to create the curriculum, assessments and any other criteria that students must achieve to earn a general diploma via a CPE pathway.
- 8 3. Students first entering twelfth grade in the two thousand eigh-9 teen--two thousand nineteen school year and thereafter shall be eligible 10 to earn a diploma via a CPE pathway.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
