AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assault on a library employee

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as sepa-2 rately amended by chapters 268 and 281 of the laws of 2016, is amended 3 to read as follows:
