AN ACT to amend a chapter of the laws of 2018 establishing the digital currency task force, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9013 and A. 8783-B, in relation to increasing the number of members on the task force

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of a chapter of the laws of 2018 establishing the digital currency task force, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9013 and A. 8783-B, is amended to read as follows:

- § 2. 1. The task force shall consist of $[\frac{nine}{nine}]$ thirteen members as follows:
 - a. [three] seven members appointed by the governor;
 - b. two members appointed by the temporary president of the senate;
 - c. two members appointed by the speaker of the assembly;
- d. one member appointed by the minority leader of the senate; and
- 10 e. one member appointed by the minority leader of the assembly.
- 11 2. The members of the task force shall receive no compensation for 12 their services, but shall be allowed their actual and necessary expenses
- 13 incurred in the performance of their duties pursuant to this act.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same
- 15 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2018 establishing the digital curren-
- 16 cy task force, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9013 and A.
- 17 8783-B, takes effect.
