AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to establishing a third county court judgeship in the county of Tompkins

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 50 of section 182 of the judiciary law, as 2 amended by chapter 125 of the laws of 1970, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 50. Tompkins, [two] three;
- 5 § 2. A new office of judge of the county court of the county of Tomp-6 kins is hereby established. Each county court judge in the county of Tompkins, in office or hereafter elected, shall also act as and 8 discharge the duties of county court judge, judge of the family court 9 and surrogate of such county.
- 10 § 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2020; provided, however, 11 that the additional office of county court judge created pursuant to
- 12 this act shall first be filled at the general election to be held on
- 13 November 5, 2019.
