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AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to extending the number of days within a twelve month period a facility may receive reimbursement for a reserved bed

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 25 of section 2808 of the public health law, as amended by section 2 of part E of chapter 57 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

(ii) payment to a facility for reserved bed days provided on behalf of such person for therapeutic leaves of absence may not exceed ten days in any twelve month period. Provided, however, should such person's individual care plan provide for therapeutic leave, payment to a facility for reserve bed days on behalf of such person for non-hospitalization leaves may not exceed twenty-five days in any twelve month period.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
