AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to establishing a temporary liquor permit

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a
2 new section 97-b to read as follows:

3 § 97-b. Temporary liquor permit. The liquor authority is hereby
4 authorized to issue temporary permits effective for a period not to
5 exceed twenty-four consecutive hours to authorize the sale of liquor,
6 alcohol and spirits manufactured by a distiller with a class D
7 distiller's license as defined in section sixty-one of this chapter, at
8 outdoor or indoor gatherings, functions, occasions or events located in
9 a municipality with a population of less than one million, within the
10 hours fixed by or pursuant to subdivision five of section one hundred
11 six of this chapter, during which alcoholic beverages may lawfully be
12 sold or served upon premises licensed to sell alcoholic beverages at
13 retail for on-premises consumption in the community in which is located
14 the premises in which such gathering, function, occasion or event is
15 held. The fee for such permit shall be seventy-two dollars. Such permit
16 and the exercise of the privilege granted thereby shall be subject to
17 such rules of the liquor authority as it deems necessary.

18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
