AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to exempting certain statements relating to sexual abuse or misconduct from disclosure

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subdivision 2 of section 87 of the public officers law, as added by chapter 933 of the laws of 1977, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (e) are compiled for law enforcement purposes and which, if disclosed, 5 would:
- 6 i. interfere with law enforcement investigations or judicial 7 proceedings;
- 8 ii. deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or impartial adjudi-9 cation;
- iii. identify a confidential source or disclose confidential information relating to a criminal investigation; [ex]
- iv. reveal criminal investigative techniques or procedures, except routine techniques and procedures; or
- v. reveal any statement made by a witness or victim relating to sexual
  abuse or misconduct;
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
