AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to notifying local officials of the occurrence of certain emergency situations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 352 of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
- 7. Upon the occurrence of an emergency where an imminent imperilment to the public health and safety exists, in addition to those individuals he or she would have otherwise notified, the county health commissioner shall immediately notify the following individuals of the existence of such emergency:
- 8 (a) the chief executive officer of each municipality affected by the 9 emergency;
- 10 (b) each member of the legislative body of the county in which the 11 emergency exists who represents the area affected by the emergency; and
- 12 (c) where the emergency affects another county, the county health
- 13 commissioner of the affected county or counties.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
