AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to liability under the unemployment insurance law of certain limited liability partnerships and companies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 512 of the labor law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

2-a. For the purposes of this article, the term "employer" includes a partner of a registered limited liability partnership as defined in section two of the partnership law, a member of a limited liability company as defined in subdivision (m) of section one hundred two of the limited liability company law or a member of a professional service limited liability company as defined in subdivision (f) of section twelve hundred one of the limited liability company law; provided, however, that such limited liability partnerships and companies shall not include those which are less than two persons.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
