AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring certain buses and trucks be equipped with commercial GPS devices

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 1 2 adding a new subdivision 53 to read as follows: 3 53. Every bus, omnibus and commercial truck operating upon the public 4 highways of the state, shall be equipped with a commercial GPS device. 5 Such GPS device must: (a) allow the capability of entering into the device the dimensions of the vehicle, including length, width, height б 7 and weight; and (b) provide route directions that account for commercial 8 truck restrictions such as bridge heights and clearances, load limits, 9 one-way road designations, and left-hand and dangerous turn 10 restrictions. The GPS device shall be kept in good operating condition 11 at all times and must be mounted in a place readily accessible for use. § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 12 13 have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment 14 and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation 15 of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and 16 completed on or before such effective date.
