AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to credit cards issued by gas stations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 518-b to read as follows:

§ 518-b. Gas station credit cards. 1. A gas station shall charge the same rate for purchases of gasoline made by a credit card issued by such gas station, or the parent company or any subsidiary thereof as it charges for purchases made by cash.

2. For the purposes of this section, the term:

(a) "gas station" shall mean a filling station where fuel is stored primarily for sale by delivery directly into the ordinary fuel tank connected with the engine of a motor vehicle to be consumed in the operation of such motor vehicle or where such fuel is stored primarily for sale by delivery directly into the ordinary fuel tank connected with the engine of a vessel to be consumed in the operation of such vessel.

(b) "credit card" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in section five hundred eleven of this article.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall have become a law.
