AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to periodic diagnostic and treatment center inspection

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 2801 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- 3 12. "Diagnostic and treatment center" means any hospital as defined by 4 <u>subdivision</u> one of this section operating as a diagnostic and treatment center authorized to provide ambulatory surgical services, including but not limited to diagnostic and treatment centers regulated by Part seven 7 hundred fifty-five or Part seven hundred fifty-six of Title ten of the 8 New York Code of Rules and Regulations.
- 9 § 2. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2827 to 10 read as follows:
- 11 § 2827. Powers and duties of the commissioner. 1. The commissioner shall promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of 12 13 this article, including, but not limited to, regulations establishing 14 standards for cleanliness, hygiene, and safety.
- 2. The department, under the direction of the commissioner, shall 16 inspect each diagnostic and treatment center not less than every thirty-nine months. The commissioner may appoint and designate, from time to time, persons to make the inspections authorized by this article.
- 19 3. The commissioner shall create a report every thirty-nine months 20 indicating the results of all individual inspections and deliver a copy 21 to the assembly, the senate, and the governor.
- 22 4. The commissioner may by regulation authorize any county or munici-23 pal department of health to administer this section within its jurisdic-24 tion.
- 25 5. Provisions of this section shall not apply to facilities accredited 26 by the joint commission on accreditation of healthcare organizations.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
