AN ACT to amend the lien law, in relation to disclosing if the property subject to lien is real property improved or to be improved with a single family dwelling

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 9 of the lien law, as amended by
2 chapter 515 of the laws of 1929, is amended to read as follows:

3 7. The property subject to the lien, with a description thereof sufficient for identification; and if in a city or village, its location by
4 street and number, if known; whether the property subject to the lien is
5 (a) real property improved or to be improved with a single family dwelling
6 or (b) not real property improved or to be improved with a single
7 family dwelling. A failure to state the name of the true owner or
8 contractor, or a misdescription of the true owner, shall not affect the
9 validity of the lien. The notice must be verified by the lienor or his
10 agent, to the effect that the statements therein contained are true to
11 his knowledge except as to the matters therein stated to be alleged on
12 information and belief, and that as to those matters he believes it to
13 be true.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
