AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to making all state lands subject to taxation for school purposes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 536 of the real property tax law, paragraph (c) of subdivision 1 as amended by chapter 881 of the laws of 1961, paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 as amended by section 4 of part CC of chapter 58 of the laws of 2018, paragraph (f) of subdivision 1 as added by section 1 of part W of chapter 62 of the laws of 2006, and paragraph (g) of subdivision 1 as added by chapter 627 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

§ 536. [~~Certain state~~] State lands subject to taxation for school purposes only. 1. [~~The following~~] All state lands shall be subject to taxation for school purposes[+]

2. For the purposes of this section, [~~such~~] school districts, whether or not reorganized, shall be deemed to continue to exist with the boundaries that were in effect at the time the state lands therein were first subjected to taxation for school purposes.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all taxable years after this act shall have become a law.
