Introduced by M. of A. PEOPLES-STOKES -- read once and referred to the Committee on Education -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to providing for the election of members of the board of education of the Buffalo city school district in November; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph 3 of paragraph d of subdivision 10 of section
 2553 of the education law is REPEALED.

3 § 2. Subparagraphs 1 and 2 of paragraph d and paragraphs g, j, m, n, o 4 and p of subdivision 10 of section 2553 of the education law, as added 5 by chapter 242 of the laws of 1974, paragraph g as amended by chapter 6 431 of the laws of 2012 and paragraph p as amended by chapter 95 of the 7 laws of 1979, are amended to read as follows:

(1) Such election for such office shall be governed by the provisions 8 of the election law in the same manner as candidates for office general-9 10 ly to be elected by the voters of the city of Buffalo [except, as the 11 case may be, as to the date of the election; and, further provided, 12 however, that]. Notwithstanding section 6-142 of the election law, each 13 such candidate for election as a member of the board of education from a 14 city school subdistrict shall be required to file a petition containing signatures of at least five hundred registered voters of such city 15 school subdistrict in which he is a candidate and each candidate for 16 election to the board of education by the voters at large shall be 17 18 required to file a petition containing the signatures of at least one 19 thousand registered voters of the city of Buffalo.

20 (2) No petition shall contain any political party or independent body 21 name or label. Each petition shall contain the name of only one candi-22 date and such petition shall be filed with [the clerk of] the board of

The petition shall be authenticated by witnesses. Such statement shall periods as the equivalent of an affidavit, and if false shall subject the witness to the same penalties as if he or she had been duly sworn. The form of such statement shall be substantially as follows:

Objections to petitions for the nomination of members of such board 45 of education, procedures and remedies applicable to such objections 46 shall be [the same as those applicable to independent nominating 47 petitions under the election law, except as it may be modified by the 48 provisions of paragraph (d) and paragraph (n) of this subdivision] made 49 pursuant to section 6-154 of the election law.

If a candidate, after a petition in his behalf shall have been duly 1 2 filed with [the clerk of] the board of elections, and prior to the date 3 of the election, shall decline to accept the nomination, die, remove 4 from the school district, accept [or be a candidate for] another [elec-5 tive] office, or become otherwise disqualified for such city school б district office, [a further petition may be filed with such clerk, nomi-7 nating another candidate in his place and stead. Such further petition 8 shall in all respects comply with the provisions of paragraphs d, f and 9 h of this subdivision, except that it may be filed at any time up to and including the fifteenth day preceding the date of the election pursuant 10 11 to the provisions of this subdivision and the time within which to accept or object to such further petition shall be computed from the 12 13 date of filing or said fifteenth day, whichever is earlier] such vacancy 14 shall be filled by the committee on vacancies pursuant to the election 15 law. 16 n. [The] For members elected in November, two thousand twenty the term 17 of office for each member of such board from a city school subdistrict shall be two years, and for each member elected at large shall be four 18 years and upon the expiration of such terms, the term of office of each 19 20 member of such board from a city school subdistrict shall be three 21 years, and the term of office of each such member of the board elected at large shall be for five years. Of the candidates to be elected for 22 membership on the board of education of the city school district of the 23 24 city of Buffalo by the voters at large the three candidates receiving

the largest number of votes cast in the city, shall be declared elected as at-large members of such board of education. In each city school subdistrict the candidates seeking the election as the member of such board of education for such city school subdistrict receiving a plurality of votes in such city school subdistrict shall be declared elected to that position.

31 Whenever a vacancy shall occur or exist in the office of member of the 32 board of education except by reason of expiration of term or increase in the number of members of such board, such vacancy shall be filled by a 33 34 majority vote of the remaining members of the board of education within 35 thirty days of the date when such vacancy shall have occurred. If the 36 remaining members of the board of education shall fail to fill such 37 vacancy within such thirty day period, then the mayor of the city of Buffalo shall within thirty days thereafter fill such vacancy subject to 38 39 the confirmation of such appointment by the common council of the city of Buffalo. No one shall be appointed to fill a vacancy of a subdistrict 40 41 member of the board of education unless he fulfills all of the quali-42 fications in this subdivision to enable him to be a candidate for the office of a member of the board of education from the subdistrict 43 44 involved.

o. The members so elected to the board of education shall convene on the first business day in [July] January of each year, at the time of the commencement of their term of office and select from their members a president who shall serve for a term of one year or such other term, not exceeding the term of his office, as may be fixed by the rules and regulations of the board.

51 p. The election of members of the board of education of the school 52 district of the city of Buffalo shall take place on [May seventh, nine-53 teen hundred seventy-four] November third, two thousand twenty and on 54 the first Tuesday <u>after the first Monday</u> in [May] November thereafter in 55 each year in which an incumbent's term expires. Such election shall be 56 conducted by the board of elections of the county of Erie in the same

1 manner as other elections are conducted by it. [Polls shall be open for 2 voting for the hours prescribed by section 8-100 of the election law for 3 **primary elections.**] The results of such elections, after canvassing, 4 shall be certified and reported by the board of elections to the board 5 of education of such city. The clerk or other appropriate officer of б the board of education shall within twenty-four hours after receipt of such certification by the board of elections serve a written notice 7 8 either personally or by mail upon each person declared to be elected as 9 a member of the board of education informing him of his election and the length of his term. 10 § 3. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, the term of 12 every member of the board of education of the city school district of 13 Buffalo, which term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2020, is hereby 14 extended from June thirtieth of the year in which it is scheduled to 15 expire to December thirty-first of such year. Terms of such members 16 elected after this act becomes law shall begin on the first day of Janu-17 ary and end on the last day of December of the appropriate year.

18 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
