AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to prohibiting the addition or change to certain wage orders which would have the effect of requiring an employer to pay an employee for time not actually worked

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 659 of the labor law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 3 to read as follows:

- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any new wage order or regulation or revision of an existing wage order or regulation issued or adopted by the commissioner on or after January first, two thousand twenty shall not be valid if such wage order or regulation would have the effect of requiring an employer to pay an employee for time not actually worked.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
