AN ACT to amend the legislative law, in relation to requiring that all members of the senate and assembly have a minimum number of bills brought to the chamber floor for consideration and vote every legislative session calendar year

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The legislative law is amended by adding a new section 5-b 2 to read as follows:

§ 5-b. Floor votes on legislation. Each member of the senate and assembly shall have a minimum of five bills, not including any budget or appropriation bills, brought to the floor for a vote every legislative session calendar year. No bill may be held in committee indefinitely to circumvent the requirements of this section.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
