AN ACT to amend the economic development law, in relation to company disclosure of employees having H1-B visas

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 47 of section 100 of the economic development law, as renumbered by chapter 427 of the laws of 2008, is renumbered subdivision 48 and a new subdivision 47 is added to read as follows: <u>47. The commissioner shall require any company receiving funding</u> <u>pursuant to this chapter to disclose the number of its total employees</u> <u>issued an H1-B visa by United States citizenship and immigration</u> <u>services in the department of homeland security.</u> § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
