AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring consumer reporting agencies to provide a consumer's information to such consumer at no cost

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 380-d of the general business 2 law, as added by chapter 867 of the laws of 1977, is amended to read as 3 follows:

- (a) Every consumer reporting agency shall <u>at any time</u>, upon request and proper identification of any consumer, <u>and at no cost to the consumer</u>, clearly and accurately disclose to the consumer:
- (1) all information in its files at the time of the request concerning such consumer; and
- 9 (2) the sources of the information; except that the sources of infor10 mation acquired solely for use in preparing an investigative consumer
 11 report and actually used for no other purpose need not be disclosed;
 12 provided, however, that in the event an action is brought under section
 13 three hundred eighty-n of this article, such sources shall be available
 14 to the plaintiff under appropriate discovery procedures in the court in
 15 which the action is brought; and
- 16 (3) the recipients of any consumer report on the consumer which it has 17 furnished;
- 18 (i) for employment purposes within the two-year period preceding the 19 request, and
- 20 (ii) for any other purpose within the six month period preceding the 21 request.
- 22 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
