AN ACT to create the empire state cricket task force; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created the empire state cricket task force 2 to conduct a comprehensive study and create strategies to promote the game of cricket in New York State. The scope of such study shall include:

(a) an examination of the various formats of the game of cricket and 6 the location of leagues, clubs, teams, tournaments, academies, colleges, school programs and cricket fields across the state;

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- (b) an examination of the financial impact the sport of cricket could 8 9 have on local and state economies;
- (c) the creation of strategies to promote and expand the game of 11 cricket in the state; and
- 12 (d) a review of any other related information that may assist in 13 carrying out such study of the game of cricket.
- § 2. The empire state cricket task force shall consist of eight members having experience and expertise in the game of cricket. Such 14 15 16 task force shall consist of: two members appointed by the governor; two 17 members appointed by the temporary president of the senate; one member 18 appointed by the minority leader of the senate; two members appointed by the speaker of the assembly; and one member appointed by the minority 19 20 leader of the assembly.

EXPLANATION -- Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 § 3. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation but shall 2 be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses in the performance 3 of their duties pursuant to this act.

- § 4. A report of the findings and recommendations of the task force shall be submitted to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, and the speaker of the assembly no more than two years after the feftetive date of this act.
- 8  $\S$  5. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 9 deemed repealed June 30, 2022.
