AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to applied behavior analysis

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 8802 of the education law, as 1 2 added by chapter 554 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows: 3 1. The practice of applied behavior analysis by a "licensed behavior 4 analyst" shall mean the design, implementation and evaluation of envi-5 ronmental modifications, using behavioral stimuli and consequences, to б produce socially significant improvement in human behavior, including 7 the use of direct observation, measurement, and functional analysis of 8 the relationship between environment and behavior [, pursuant to a diag-9 nosis and prescription or order from a person who is licensed or other-10 wise authorized to provide such diagnosis and prescription or ordering 11 services pursuant to a profession enumerated in this title, for the 12 purpose of providing behavioral health treatment for persons with autism 13 and autism spectrum disorders and related disorders].

14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
