AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the crime of aggravated assault upon a police officer or a peace officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 120.11 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 283 2 of the laws of 1993, is amended to read as follows:

§ 120.11 Aggravated assault upon a police officer or a peace officer.

A person is guilty of aggravated assault upon a police officer or a 5 peace officer when, with intent to cause serious physical injury to a person whom he knows or reasonably should know to be a police officer or a peace officer engaged in the course of performing his official duties, he causes such injury [by means of a deadly weapon or dangerous instru-9 ment].

10 Aggravated assault upon a police officer or a peace officer is a class 11 B felony.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
