Introduced by M. of A. STEC -- read once and referred to the Committee on Local Governments

AN ACT to amend chapter 491 of the laws of 2018 relating to incorporating the Volunteer Exempt Firefighter's Benevolent Association of Whitehall, New York and providing for its powers and duties, in relation to the disposition of foreign fire insurance premium taxes received by such corporation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 7 of chapter 491 of the laws of 2018 relating to
2 incorporating the Volunteer Exempt Firefighter's Benevolent Association
3 of Whitehall, New York and providing for its powers and duties, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 § 7. Precept for payment of foreign fire insurance premium taxes. Such
6 corporation shall collect and there shall be paid to it all taxes
7 imposed by article 91 of the insurance law for fire department use and
8 benefit, upon premiums for insurance against loss or damage by fire
9 covering property situated in the Whitehall fire protection district, in
10 the town of Whitehall and county of Washington, or within any duly
11 organized territory in which the Whitehall Volunteer Fire Company, Inc.
12 is or may be obligated to render fire protection. The officer of said
13 corporation designated by its by-laws to collect and receive the afore-
14 said tax shall have all the powers and be subject to all the provisions
15 of the insurance law, relating to treasurers of fire departments. Such
16 corporation shall also be entitled to receive a share of the tax imposed
17 by article 91 of the insurance law, based upon the business written in
18 the territory with respect to which it is entitled to collect and
19 receive the tax under article 91 of the insurance law. [~~Such taxes shall
20 only be used for the care and relief of disabled or indigent volunteer
21 and exempt volunteer firefighters and their families.~~]

22 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
