AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Hartwick as the "Sergeant John Kempe Winslow Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-i to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-i. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Sergeant John Kempe Winslow Memorial Highway". All that portion of the 5 state highway system constituting state route two hundred five in the 6 town of Hartwick, county of Otsego, beginning at the intersection with 7 Scotch Hill Road, continuing in a generally southerly direction, and 8 terminating at the intersection with Rod Gun Club Road, shall be designated and known as the "Sergeant John Kempe Winslow Memorial Highway".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-13 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 15 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 16 changed as a result of this act.
- 17 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
