AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to enacting the "New York state teleworking expansion act"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "New York state teleworking expansion act".
- 3 \S 2. The civil service law is amended by adding a new section 13 to 4 read as follows:
- § 13. Teleworking programs. 1. Each state agency shall establish, pursuant to a collective bargaining agreement or other binding arrangement with its employees, a policy and program to allow employees to perform all or a portion of their duties through teleworking to the maximum extent possible without diminished employee performance. Each state agency shall designate a "telework coordinator" to be responsible for overseeing the implementation of teleworking programs.
 - 2. For the purposes of this section, the term:

- 13 (a) "telework" shall mean to perform normal and regular work functions
 14 on a workday that ordinarily would be performed at the state agency's
 15 principal location at a different location, thereby eliminating or
 16 substantially reducing the physical commute to and from such state agen17 cy's principal location; and
- 18 (b) "state agency" shall mean any state department, board, bureau,
 19 division, commission, committee, public authority, public benefit corpo20 ration, council, office, or other governmental entity performing a
 21 governmental or proprietary function for the state.
- 22 § 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 23 have become a law.
