AN ACT to amend the military law, in relation to the issuance of a New York State Korean War Service Medal

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 247 of the military law is amended by adding a new

subdivision 1-d to read as follows: 3 1-d. The adjutant general is hereby authorized to present in the name of the legislature of the state of New York, a medal, to be known as the "New York State Korean War Service Medal", bearing a suitable inscription, to any person: (i) who is a citizen of the state of New 7 York, or (ii) who was a citizen of the state of New York while serving in the armed forces of the United States; (iii) who served in the United 9 States Armed Forces, defined as army, air force, navy, marine corps, or 10 coast quard, or the organized militia on active duty abroad in the Kore-11 an War during the period of time from June twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred fifty through July twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred fifty-three; 12 and (iv) who was honorably discharged or released under honorable 13 14 circumstances during the Korean War. Not more than one New York State 15 Korean War Service Medal shall be awarded or presented, under the provisions of this subdivision, to any person whose entire service 16 subsequent to the time of the receipt of such medal shall not have been 17 honorable. For each succeeding star as provided herein, such person 18 shall be entitled to wear, as the chief of staff of the state may 19 direct, a ribbon whose color and design shall be selected by the divi-20 sion of military affairs. In the event of the death of any person during 22 or subsequent to the receipt of such certificate it shall be presented to such representative of the deceased as may be designated. The adju-23 tant general, in consultation with the director of the division of 25 veterans' affairs, shall make such rules and regulations as may be

deemed necessary for the proper presentation and distribution of such medals.

- § 2. Subdivision 4 of section 247 of the military law, as amended by chapter 332 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows:
- 4. This section shall not be construed to require that a recipient of the conspicuous service cross, the conspicuous service star, the Cold War Certificate [ex], the New York State Silver Rose Veterans Service Certificate or the New York State Korean War Service Medal has been a resident of the state of New York at the time of his or her entry into the United States army, air force, navy, marine corps, or nurses corps.
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law. The division of military and naval affairs is authorized to promulgate any and all rules and regulations and take any other measures necessary to implement the provisions of this act on its effective date on or before such date.
