AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to clarifying that reasonable accommodation to enable a person with a disability to use and enjoy a dwelling includes the use of an animal to alleviate the symptoms or effects of a disability

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subparagraph 2 of paragraph (d) of subdivision 2-a of section 296 of the executive law, as amended by chapter 196 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (2) To refuse to make reasonable accommodations in rules, policies, 5 practices, or services, when such accommodations may be necessary to 6 afford a person with a disability equal opportunity to use and enjoy a dwelling, including the use of an animal as a reasonable accommodation 8 to alleviate symptoms or effects of a disability, and including reasonable modification to common use portions of the dwelling, or
- 10 § 2. Paragraph 2 of subdivision 18 of section 296 of the executive 11 law, as amended by chapter 196 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read 12 as follows:
- 13 (2) To refuse to make reasonable accommodations in rules, policies,
 14 practices, or services, when such accommodations may be necessary to
 15 afford said person with a disability equal opportunity to use and enjoy
 16 a dwelling, including the use of an animal as a reasonable accommodation
 17 to alleviate symptoms or effects of a disability, and including reason18 able modification to common use portions of the dwelling, or
- 19 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
