AN ACT relating to the name and character of the Dr. John Henrik Clarke House in Harlem, New York

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Dr. John Henrik Clarke House, a landmark structure located at 286 Convent Avenue, Harlem, New York 10031, shall henceforth remain a cultural and educational institution and shall retain the name of "the Dr. John Henrik Clarke House" in perpetuity.

6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
