AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to including hexavalent chromium in the list of emerging contaminants

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph c of subdivision 3 of section 1112 of the public health law, as added by section 1 of part M of chapter 57 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

c. The commissioner shall, at a minimum, include the following chemicals identified as emerging contaminants: 1,4-dioxane; <u>hexavalent chro-</u>
<u>mium (chromium-6);</u> perfluorooctanesulfonic acid; and perfluorooctanoic
acid.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
